Where to start

Once you have decided you or your staff need the Food Hygiene training and assessment, ring us on 01706 252352.

- complete a registration form for you
- register you with learndirect Business
- issue an invoice

On receipt of your payment (cash is best if you are in a hurry), we will

- email you an enrolment key so you can log on to your course

When you have completed the course and are ready to take the assessment, we will

- book you in at our test centre at Futures Park, Bacup (Tuesdays and Fridays are test days)
- guide you through the test procedure - you will need to bring some photographic ID with you (passport/driving licence)
- give you your result at the end of the assessment
- give you a printed report of your result - you will receive your RIPH certificate within a month.

The Online Assessment consists of 30 randomly generated questions - Pass = 20 -25 marks, Credit = 26 - 30 marks. Candidates who score 19 marks or below will fail the assessment and will not be awarded a certificate.

- Takes 45 minutes or less
